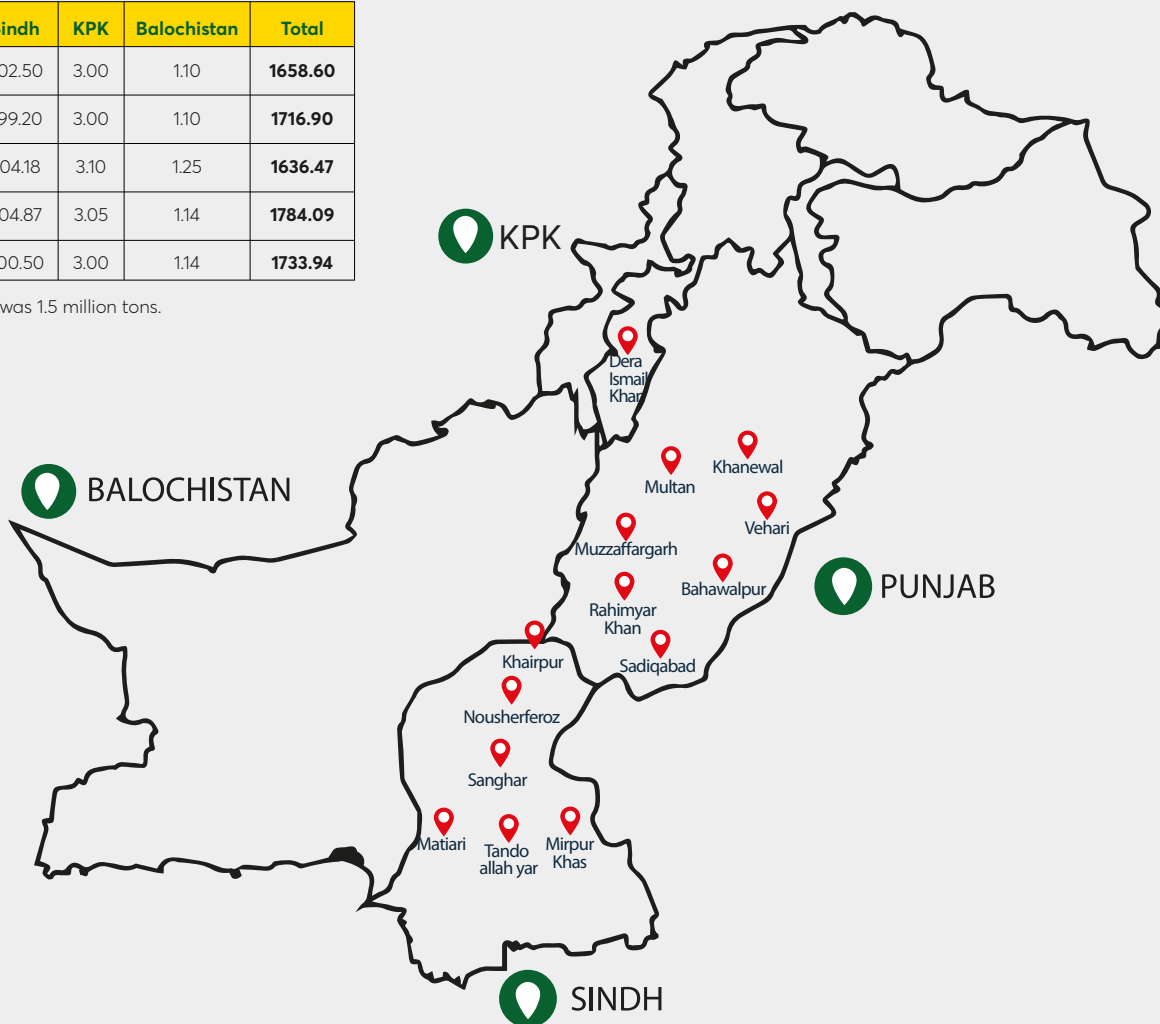

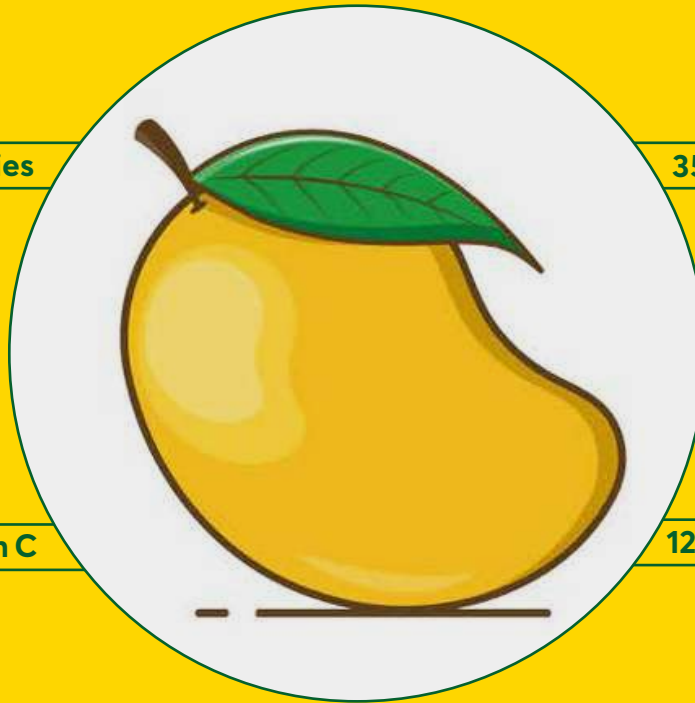
Production

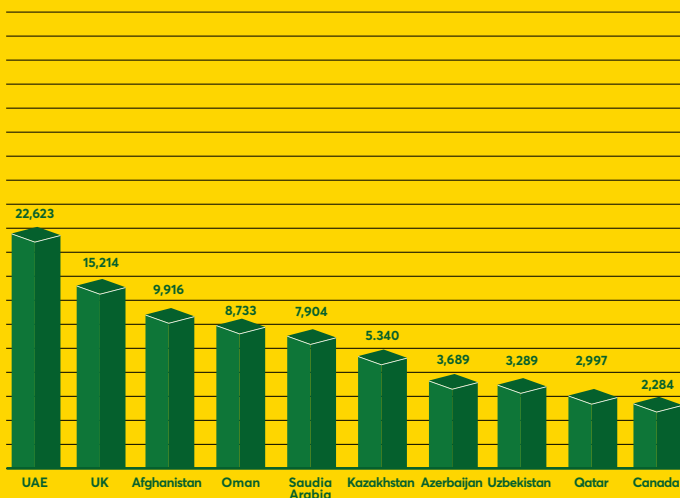
